The (RPT) is seeking individuals from the trans, two-spirit, intersex and gender diverse communities to join our Table. The Table is comprised of 50% individual members from the community and 50% community agencies.

We believe that participation of members of the trans, Two-Spirit, gender diverse and intersex communities is vital to the success of this planning work. We recognize that our work must reflect the full diversity of trans communities and welcome applications from all.

We are seeking individuals who can make a two-year commitment. Each year, the Table meets approximately nine times and holds one full-day retreat. Meetings typically take place in the evenings for approximately three hours.

Honoraria

Individual RPT community members may receive an honorarium of \$25 per hour for meetings attended and for assigned, required tasks to an annual maximum of 45 hours.
